

Watchtower 1\4\72 - "Does Jehovah have a prophet...Who is this prophet? This 'prophet' was not one man, but was a body of men and women....Today they are known as Jehovah's Christian Witnesses."

Watchtower 15\3\72 - "Was there any group on whom Jehovah would be willing to bestow the commission to

speak as a 'prophet' in his name, as was done toward Ezekiel back in 613 BCE?

Watchtower 15\4\43 - "This is not giving any credit to the magazine's publishers, but is due to the great Author of the Bible...He it is that makes possible the material that is published in the columns of this magazine."

The Time is at Hand, 1889 - "In this volume we offer a chain of testimony...it is beyond the breadth and depth of human thought, and therefore cannot be of human origin."
