## HYPOCRITICAL JUDGMENT!



**THE July 15th 1997 issue of the Watchtower magazine contains an article entitled "The Investigative Judgment" A Bible Based Doctrine?"**

**First & Last Ministries joins information super-highway.**

The article is basically a refutation of a key doctrine held by the Seventh Day Adventist Church, based on Daniel 8 14, which teaches that upon Christ's ascension to heaven, He entered the holy part of the Heavenly Sanctuary

But, in the year AD 1844 He entered the Most Holy compartment where He cleansed the sanctuary by His blood (as depicted by the High Priest on the Day of Atonement) and began a judgment work on all professed Christians (living and dead) to see if they were worthy or not to be written in the Lamb's Book of Life

Now while the above WT article, in the main, does a fairly good job in refuting this teaching, in usual fashion the WT Society shoots a big hole in its own foot during the process

For example, on page 26 as part of its arsenal against the S D A s, the WT Society quotes Professor Anthony A Hoekema to back up its article, but fails to say where the quote comes from

The simple reason for this oversight is that Anthony

Hoekema made his statement on page 146 of his major work "Four Major Cults" A book in which Jehovah's Witnesses also have their own boat blown clear out of the water

So while the WT article quotes and documents other statements from different sources, it wants rank and file JW's to be kept in ignorance of their quote from Professor Hoekema's work

For while the Governing Body may read opposition literature, it doesn't want rank and file JW's to do the same (information control is a cult hallmark)

So, in this brief treatment of the WT article we have to reach our own investigative judgment which can be none other than that of our Lord Jesus Christ in His stern words of Matthew 7 1-5

The WT Society attempts to remove a splinter from the eye of Seventh Day Adventism, while a huge plank lies in its own eye

In the words of Jesus Christ we offer the only verdict possible "Thou Hypocrite!"

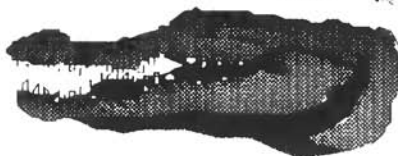

# LEVIATHAN

OR

## RAMBLING

“The description of Leviathan at Job 41:1-34 aptly fits the crocodile.”

So says the June 8th 1997 issue of the Awake! magazine in a two-page article investigating the background of the creature, which is mentioned six times in the book of Job

But has this view always been held by the Watch Tower Society.

Unsurprisingly the answer is no. In fact, at one time the Society didn't even believe Leviathan was a creature at all - but, instead, a steam train!!

On page 84 of Charles Taze Russell's posthumous work The Finished Mystery, readers are given an imaginative description of the beast of Job 41 where it says:-

“Behold now one with great heat (the stationary steam engine), which I have made to be with thee; he will consume fodder (peat, wood, coal) as do cattle. Behold now his strength is in his loins (boiler plates), and his power is within the parts bent in a circle (boiler shell) of his belly. His tail (smoke stack - opposite the feeding end) will set upright like a cedar; the couplings of his leaping parts (connecting rods, pitmans) will be clamped together. His bones are tubes of copper, his solid bones (grate bars) are as hammered-out bars of iron. He is the greatest of the ways of power. He that made him (the Lord) can make his sword (Word) to approach unto (reveal) him.”

On page 85 of the book this nonsensical rambling continues with a translation of Job 41:1-34

“Thou wilt lengthen out leviathan (the locomotive) with a hook (automatic coupler) or with a snare (coupling pin) which thou wilt cause his tongue (coupling link) to drop down. Wilt thou not place a ring (piston) in his nostrils (cylinders) or pierce through his cheeks (piston ends) with a staff (piston rod)? Will he make repeated supplications unto thee (to get off the track)? Or will he utter soft tones unto thee (when he screeches with the whistle)? Will he make a covenant with thee, that thou mayest take him for a servant forever (without repairs)?.....”

And so the translation continues

## PROOF

As I write this article and read the Watch Tower book for myself, even I find it hard to believe people actually took all this in

Nowadays, of course, the Society would never own up to believing such rubbish and present-day Witnesses will probably have no idea that the article even exists

But, if proof was ever needed of the lengths the Watch Tower Society will go to, in order to make the Bible fit in with its own theology, then this must surely be it

## Suicide cult begins search for new converts.

MEMBERS of the Heaven's Gate cult held their first meeting in August, since 39 of them committed mass suicide earlier this year

The gathering in the California university town of Berkeley has horrified university officials and cult-watchers who fear a repeat of the gruesome discovery, six months ago, of the United States' largest ever group suicide.

The bodies of cult founder Marshall Applewhite (pictured above) and his followers were found dead in a San Diego mansion, laid out on their beds under purple shrouds. They had drunken vodka, eaten apple sauce laced with drugs and suffocated themselves with plastic bags

Now the group, led by 55-year-old computer programmer Chuck Humphrey, has been leafleting new students at the university in an effort to recruit new converts.

A Heaven's Gate Internet site is already attracting 50 visitors a day and offers copies of a promotional video by mail order

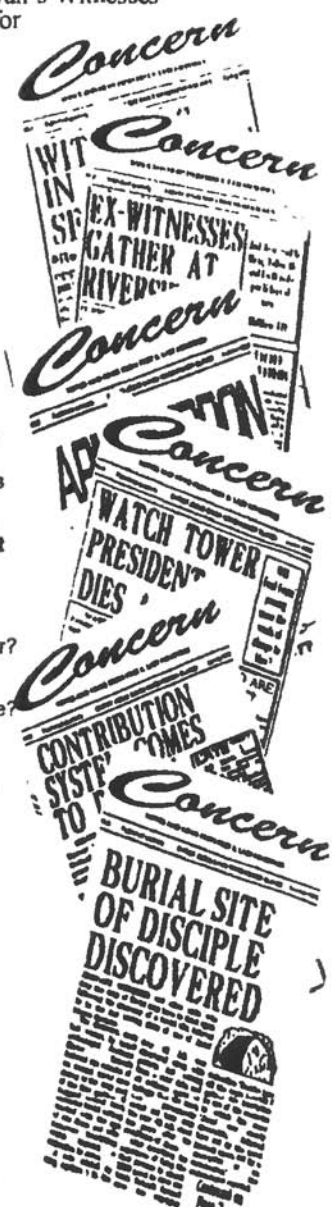

# *A Christian Response to the Watchtower Article*

## *"What Do The Scriptures Say About the Divinity of Christ?"*

### **Part One by Tom and Ella McGree**

THE Bible clearly teaches there is only one God, Isaiah 45 5 He alone is the true God But the Bible also teaches there are many gods Because the same Hebrew and Greek words are used for "God" and "gods", the Bible translations have used a capital letter when referring to God

Christians believe this God to be the Creator, Sustainer of our world and Saviour Because of this, He alone is worshipped

We cannot bow down to, serve, pray to, sing praises to or sacrifice at the table of any other god

The article asks a very important question Unless Jesus is god, we cannot bow down to Him, serve Him, pray to Him, sing His praises or sit at His table To do any of these things would be idolatry

Firstly then: Is Jesus the Creator? The Bible says "Yes" He is!

Hebrews 1 10 addressed to the Son (verse 8) states -

"You, Lord, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth and the heavens are the work of your hands"

Colossians 1 16 says - "All things were created by Him and for Him"

Secondly Does the Son sustain all things? Yes!

Colossians 1 17 - "by Him all things consist - cohere, are held together" - The Amplified Bible

Hebrews 1 3 - "upholding all things by the word of His power - upholding and maintaining and guiding and propelling the universe" - The Amplified Bible

Thirdly Is the Son the Saviour? Indeed He is!

Acts 4 12 - "and there is salvation in and through no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by and in which we must be saved" - The Amplified Bible

Because of the clarity of these teachings, our Bibles in the New Testament render "theos" as God when referring to Jesus Christ.

To call Jesus - god - would mean we could not bow down or serve Him We could not call on His name in prayer, sing praises to Him or sit at His table.

If Jesus is a creature, to do any of these things would constitute idolatry

Jeremiah 10 11 states, "The gods who did not make the heavens and the earth shall perish from the earth and from under the heavens"

1 If Jesus is not Creator - He is one of the gods who will perish.

2. If Jesus is not God - we should not bow down before Him

Compare Exodus 20 5 - "You shall not bow down to them" (i.e. any god) with Philipians 2:10 - "That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow"

3 If Jesus is not God - it would be wrong to serve him

Compare Exodus 20 5 - "You shall not serve them" (any god) with Colossians 3 24 - "You serve the Lord Christ"

4 If Jesus is not God - we dare not call on His name in prayer

Compare 1 Kings 18 24 - "And call on the name of your gods and I will call on the name of the Lord" with 1 Cor 1 2 - "with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours"

5. What then of singing praises to Jesus?

Compare Exodus 15 11 - "Who among the gods is like you, O Jehovah? The one to be feared with songs of praise" with Revelation 5 8, 9, 12 - "fell down before the lamb and they sing - a new



song saying you are worthy .. the Lamb that was slaughtered is worthy to receive the power and riches and wisdom and strength and honour and glory and blessing”

Consider Matthew 21: 9,15,16 and Luke 19:40

6 If Jesus is not God - we should never sit at the Lord's table

1 Corinthians 10:16, 17, 20, 21 - “The cup of blessing .. we participate in and share a fellowship in the blood of Christ are not those who eat the sacrifices partners of the altar .. I do not want you to fellowship and be partners with diabolical spirits .. you cannot drink the Lord's cup and the demon's cup You cannot partake of the Lord's table and the demon's table” Amplified Bible

1 Corinthians 10:21 New World Translation by the Watch Tower Society reads - “You cannot be drinking the cup of Jehovah and the cup of demons, you cannot be partaking the table of Jehovah and the table of demons” note especially 1 Corinthians 10:20 NWT “no, but I say that the things which the nations sacrifice, they sacrifice to demons and not to God ..”

We need to be clear in our own minds When we speak of the Lord's evening meal or the Lord's supper, who is this Lord? If this Lord is “a god” and not God, then indeed we are sharing communion with one who is a creature and so we are guilty of idolatry

In view of all this, it would be very revealing to examine the material found in the Watchtower magazine of January 15th, 1992 on pages 20 - 23

The article poses the question “What do the scriptures say about the Divinity of Christ?”

The article finishes by saying this - “Clearly, therefore, the scriptures do not support the idea of the divinity of Christ”

In the next edition of *Concern* we shall begin our examination of this statement

# WORLD FLOCK TO DOOR Campaign Update



SINCE the launch of the **Danger At Your Door** campaign in July, there has been much to give us encouragement.

Many of you have written in to order the 4" x 4" stickers that householders can affix to their front doors asking the passing Jehovah's Witnesses not to call

Now First & Last Ministries is pleased to announce the second part of the campaign - a new warning tract aimed solely at explaining to the public, the dangers of joining the Watch Tower Society

This four-page tract (a copy of which should be enclosed with this issue of *Concern*) is designed to be presented to the public along with the warning sticker

If you would like to order more of the tracts then please see the order form on page 7 The tracts are free, but we have to make a charge for the stickers

Here at First & Last Ministries, we feel that if just one person is prevented from joining the Watch Tower Society, then the stickers will have done their job

But, we feel that these stickers will be much more powerful

Even if you just order enough to give to your immediate family, the Jehovah's Witnesses will soon get the message



EARLY indications show that our stickers are being well received by both the public and Christians But, we received a letter from a reader who said he felt unhappy about them and felt they could be counter-productive.

We enjoy receiving letters from all of you so we print the three reasons this person gave against the stickers and Bill Bacon gives his comments

**It could give Christians an easy solution and a way out of witnessing to JW's.**

The stickers are not for Christians to stick on their front doors

A Christian, who has been at the same address for 18 months should now be in the JW's' list of houses to stay clear of and not be getting visits from JW's anyway

Secondly, A Christian does not need one of our stickers on their door in order to get out of witnessing the Witness All the Christian has to do is not to open the door to the Witness in the first place, or say they are too busy to speak to them

It could give JW's a further "persecution complex", which they already have, as well as giving the householder, who you give the sticker to, the idea that we have a special vendetta against JW's.

The Jehovah's Witness invents persecution

He is taught it in his first book study

We say any organisation who ducks and dives like the Watch Tower Society is entitled to opposition

Let us not mistake opposition for persecution

**How would we react if we went out visiting in our area and found stickers saying "No visits by Evangelicals please"?**

My wife and I lived with our children in a north London road for 22 years

A five minute walk around the corner was the local Evangelical church

In those 22 years this church did not make one visit to us Nor did it leave us any literature

Later it came to our attention that there was a Baptist family living three doors away from us and they knew my wife was a JW But, again, in 22 years we never had any item pushed through our letter box to give us some warning or history of JWs

I would have given any Christian, who might have come to my door with a sticker or warning tract, the top brick off the chimney

But 99.9 per cent of Christians are stuck fast in their churches.

The dear people who live in our old road might just as well stick on their door "No Visits By Tibetan Monks Please" Because they have more chance of a Tibetan Monk calling on them than a Christian

What would I say if the street put up stickers saying "No Visits By Evangelicals Please"? I would say praise God Because it would mean that Christians had at last woken up

As Dr Martyn Lloyd-Jones said "Apathy in the Christian church is the breeding ground of the cults"

THE Watchtower magazine of May 1st 1987 must surely be a collectors' item

It asks

### Do All Prophecies Come From God?

On page four of the magazine we read

*"False religion was wiped out in the flood of Noah's day, leaving just the true form of worship practised by Jehovah's prophet Noah. The demons remained though and reintroduced counterfeit prophecies and religious concepts."*

As we move on in this WT article, page five gives us some outstanding information (or should we call it spiritual food at the right time in due season?)

*"Satan and the demons still inspire false prophecy to deceive and divide mankind, confuse true revelations about God, and establish false ideas and religions."*

I'm sure if you ask any Jehovah's Witness about false prophecies they will know some.

This article is quite mind-boggling and the quote on page six is a true classic. It reads -

**Since the completing of the Bible, those who have introduced new "prophecies," religions, and sects could not be inspired by God. True prophecies were not given to reveal new religions. They kept the one**

Watchtower 1/5/87 p.6

They finish off by saying,-

*"So all who desire to be acquainted with true prophecy and to practise true religion need to turn to the Bible. It is God's book of prophecy. His complete message to mankind."*

So we learn from the following prophecy

*"Clearly the battle of the Great Day of God Almighty is now in progress."*

WT 1/9/1916

According to the Watchtower, that it is a false demonistic prophecy and there is no such thing as "new light"

So it seems Jehovah's Witnesses don't need the Watchtower, new light or God's organisation. Instead, they need to take note of this classic Watchtower and go to the Lord Jesus Christ and the finished message of the Bible, which says -

*"For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book; If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book;*

*and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book."*
