UNITY?

Watch Tower Society in confusion over blood ban.



IN an amazing turnaround the Watch Tower Society has partially lifted its ban on blood transfusions — IN ONE COUNTRY!

In what can only be described as a case of double standards, the society now has two versions of its erroneous blood doctrine in force.

The situation has developed after the society signed a legally binding document, in the European Court of Human Rights, in March.

There it agreed that Jehovah's Witnesses, in Bulgaria, could ignore its 37 year-old prohibition on blood and will, in future, be allowed to receive blood without fear of being disfellowshipped. Meanwhile fellow Witnesses, throughout the rest of the world, will still face being shunned.

The court case came after the society took the government of Bulgaria to court because the east European country regarded the cult as a "threat to public health" and banned it from holding meetings (see last issue of Concern).

But now, even though the society has agreed to the lifting of the blood ban in Bulgaria, the society has no intention of telling Jehovah's Witnesses in other countries, of the change.

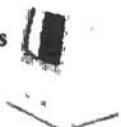

Lies, lies!

“... with regard to its stance on blood transfusions ... members should have *free choice* in the matter for themselves and their children, *without any control or sanction* on the part of the association.”

European Court of Human Rights, Application No. 28626/95

WITH these few words the society has seemingly agreed to end one of the most dangerous religious doctrines ever devised by man

But while every Jehovah's Witness should be rejoicing that they no longer face the prospect of deciding whether their loved ones should live, or face an early death, reality is somewhat different

For these words, agreed with the European Court of Human Rights, only apply to 2,000 Jehovah's Witnesses living in Bulgaria. For the other 5 million or so JW's throughout the world, accepting a blood transfusion, to save their life, will still result in them falling under the following

“the receiver of a blood transfusion must be cut off from God's people by excommunication or disfellowshipping...”

Watchtower 15th Jan 1961

So now, not only does the Watch Tower Society have a two-tier salvation system (i.e. 144,000 and the great crowd) it also has two versions of its blood doctrine in force at the same time

For an organisation that prides itself on world unity, it's going a funny way about showing it.

Once again the real truth is that the society has conveniently agreed to this statement with the European court, but really has no intention of keeping it

While Bulgarians may have been

given a free choice as to whether or not they should take a blood transfusion, you can bet that many will still refuse out of fear of being viewed as second class members

Just to prove our point, In a statement made on April 27, 1998, regarding this issue, the society said

“Bulgaria has agreed to grant the Christian Association of Jehovah's Witnesses recognition as a religion. Bulgaria also agreed to create without delay a bill that will allow alternative civilian service for those whose conscience will not allow them to engage in military service.

The agreement also includes an acknowledgement that each individual has the freedom to choose the type of medical treatment he receives. With the amicable settlement, the Witnesses agreed to withdraw their complaint against Bulgaria. (Italics ours)

Jehovah's Witnesses are pleased that, through open communication, an amicable settlement was made between the Christian Association of Jehovah's Witnesses and the Government of Bulgaria. ***The terms of the agreement do not reflect a change in the doctrine of Jehovah's Witnesses.*** Rather, the agreement reflects an increased understanding of the concerns and actions of both parties.”

So, as can be seen from the above statement, the society does not consider the agreement with Bulgaria, as a change in its doctrine. It will continue to disfellowship its members

Prince in Darkness?



FANS of pop singer Prince have been wondering what he has been talking about ever since he started lecturing them about "the cross" during his performances.

"Maybe somebody lied about the way somebody died," Prince would say, and then, "Stauros! Look it up!"

Prince, we understand, was introduced to the theory that Jesus did not die on a cross by Larry Graham, a former singer and now JW Elder.

Prince, who will be 40-years-old later this year, claims not to be a member of this religion (or any other), but seems to be only a student of their beliefs.

France Bethel Branch Closes

February 10th, 1998

BECAUSE the government of France views Jehovah's Witnesses as a sect it has imposed a 60% TAX on all literature "bought" in the country.

Unconfirmed sources say the Society has opted to move all French facilities to England and close all printing operations in France.

They say the scheme is to print literature in London and ship it to French congregations as a gift,

sidestepping the 60% TAX.

This move will take place over the next few months. French Bethelites will be reassigned to England.

The entire distribution of French literature into France will now be handled from England.

Black man becomes first Governing Body "Helper".

A FORMER black Circuit Overseer, Samuel Heard, was appointed to serve on the Watchtower's new "helpers of the Governing Body" as part of a new arrangement to replace the leadership of the Watchtower's Governing Body, most of whom are too old to run an organisation of over 5 million members.

Watchers of the Watchtower organisation will note that for years the Governing Body has endured criticism that they have no minority representation on their governing board

Rather than choose from among many "anointed" black men who have served faithfully for years in the organisation to replace ailing members or accompany them, Mr. Heard is designated as a "helper." More news will be forthcoming soon..

Millennial Dawn

A Counterfeit of Christianity

PART TWO

Charles Taze Russell

FIRST published in 1886, *Millennial Dawn*, was the earliest work of Jehovah's Witness founder Charles Taze Russell.

Although much of the book's content is an embarrassment to present day Witnesses, it still contained many unscriptural notions and false prophecies.

In 1911, just three years from Armageddon, Professor William G. Moorehead gave his opinion on the book.

Now, in the coming issues of *Concern*, you can read just what the professor had to say regarding Mr. Russell's writings.

IS JESUS A CREATURE?

1. Jesus, in His pre-human existence, was a spiritual being, higher than the angels, but a creature. (Vol. 1, pp. 177, 178, 179, 188.)

The book expressly teaches that our Lord, prior to His incarnation and during His earthly life, was only a creature, higher in the scale of being than other creatures, but not God. "We are told that our Lord, before He left His glory to become a man, was "in a form of God—a spiritual form, a spirit being; but since to be a ransom for mankind He had to be a man, of the same nature as the sinner whose substitute in death He was to become,

it was necessary that His nature be changed. And Paul tells us that He took not the nature of angels, one step lower than His own, but that He came down two steps and took the nature of man - He 'became a man'; He 'was made flesh'. (Heb. 2:16; Phil. 2:7, 8; John 1:14.)"

"Notice that this teaches not only that angelic nature is not the only order of spirit being, but that it is a lower nature than that of our Lord before He became a man; and He was not then so high as He now is, for 'God hath highly exalted Him', because of His obedience in becoming man's willing ransom. (Phil. 2:8, 9.)

He is now of the highest order of spirit being, a partaker of the Divine (Jehovah's) nature". The book further asserts: "If this principle be a correct one, it would show that God had no right to create Jesus higher than the angels, and then further to exalt Him to the Divine nature, unless He intended to do the same for all angels and for all men" (p. 188).

There is no mistaking the significance of this teaching. Jesus Christ was originally a created being, but as a reward of His obedience unto death He is now exalted to be God!

This is worse than the doctrine of Arius the Libyan which the Council of Nicea so solemnly condemned, of modern Unitarians which all evangelical Christians repudiate.

Over against this fundamental error, one that does the Lord Jesus infinite dishonour and robs us of an Almighty Saviour, we place the, inspired Word of

Scripture, John 1:1

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God" By the Word of course is meant the Son of God, Jesus Christ Three majestic truths are here set forth. (1) The Word's eternity - "In the beginning" - the noun is without the article, it is an unmarked, uncounted duration that is meant "Was", not came into existence, He was already in existence before the creation of the universe, therefore prior to all beginning, in a timeless age which transcends time, in eternity, Christ was

Millennial Dawn says there was a time when Christ was not, the Apostle John affirms there never was a, time when He was not (2) His eternal



personal existence is maintained "The Word was with God", His equality with God, for John goes on to ascribe to Him creation

(3) His Deity "And the Word was God" Most emphatic is the order of the words in the original "And God was the Word" Jesus Christ was no subordinate or created being "Who subsisting in the form of God, counted not the being on an equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a servant" (Phil 2:6-11 R V)

It is here taught that Christ existed in the form of God "The form of a thing is the mode in which it reveals itself, and that is determined by its nature" John Chrysostom long ago said: "It is not possible to be of one essence and to have the form of another" Christ existed in the form of God because He Himself is God Hence the Apostle asserts that He was God's equal, but in His self-abasement He did not hold fast to this equality but emptied Himself of it, and instead took the lowly form of a bond-servant

His humiliation presupposes His former dignity and glory Had He not been infinitely more than a created being, it would have been no renunciation to become a servant, that He already was, according to the blasphemous teaching of Dawnism Out of such a condition He could never have risen

The highest angel in heaven, far from having to stoop in order to become a servant, is but a servant and can never be aught else

But the very fact that He did humble Himself, even unto the death of the cross, is positive proof that He was not created being, no mere man, but God over all and blessed forever (Rom 9:5)

But even in His amazing self-abasement He did not renounce His glorious attributes as a Divine Person He veiled them beneath His lowly human garb, save when occasion demanded their display Both Omnipotence and Omniscience belonged to Him while on earth, and He often exhibited both in the sight of men The proof of this is abundant and conclusive

A Christian Response to the Watchtower Article "What Do the Scriptures Say About the Divinity of Christ?"

Part 4- by Tom and Ella McCrea

The Watchtower magazine of January 15, 1992 printed a four page article aimed solely at stripping Jesus of His divinity.

In the last issue of Concern Tom and Ella McCrea continued their examination of this article and asked what Scriptural proof, if any, the Watch Tower Society, presented to its readers to back up its claims.

We print the third part of their findings below.

ON page 22 of the Watchtower it goes on to describe 'Jesus' true position and although scriptures are quoted on Christ being subject to His Father, the Watchtower says Jesus is 'inferior' to the Father!

The word 'inferior' occurs 3 times in the New Testament and never in connection with Jesus' relationship with the Father

MISUNDERSTOOD

Remember Jesus is the Mediator between God and man, he, as it were, has to represent both sides. In that sense, he is subject to the Father but not inferior. A wife is not inferior to her husband. Both share the same nature.

The scripture at I Corinthians 15:24,28 is next discussed. This scripture is greatly misunderstood by JW's. They believe Christ plus 144,000 of their anointed will form a heavenly government. They will rule over the people on earth, after Armageddon, for a literal 1,000 years. Their rule will

gradually lift the sin of those on earth until at the end of the 1,000 years, all will stand perfect. However, at this point Christ will hand over the earthly subjects and the Father will rule directly over mankind. Satan will be loosed to test mankind and will be eventually destroyed along with many who follow him.

CONTRADICTS

But this is not what the Bible is saying. I Corinthians 15:24 - 27 says Christ rules until he puts all enemies under his feet. To say he hands over before Satan and death are dealt with, contradicts the Bible. Also, we must remember that Christ's kingdom is an everlasting kingdom. Daniel 7:14, Luke 1:33, 2 Peter 1:11. I Corinthians 15 is dealing with the resurrection and Christ's work as mediator. We know that Christ's death was to 'abolish death' (2 Timothy 1:10), but the complete fulfilment of that will be realised with the resurrection of the body. This takes place when Christ returns - I Corinthians 15:51 - 54, 1 Thess 4:15 - 18. The mediator will then lay down his office, at the feet of the Father.

"To say he (Christ) hands over before Satan and death are dealt with contradicts the Bible"

The truth is that although Christ lays down his office, he is pictured after that as sharing the Father's throne. Revelation 2:1, 22,23, Revelation 22:3 - 5. Compare this with Isaiah 60:19,20. I Corinthians 8:6 is quoted. JW's say this

proves only the Father is God. If this is so then only the Son is Lord. Why then does the Watchtower Organisation say that the true Lord of Malachi 3:1 is Jehovah? Why do they translate 'kyrios' - 'Lord' in their New Testament over 200 times as 'Jehovah'? Clear scriptures like Matthew 1:22, 23, Hebrews 1:6 and John 20:28 are contradicted.

THE FACTS

Regarding the use of the word 'worship' in the New Testament, here are the facts:

- ◆ The word 'worship' plus the noun formed by it occurs 61 times. Of these 22 instances are clearly divine worship, five more of worship used intransitively. A further 17 condemn idol worship, 15 cases refer to worship of Jesus and only 2 refer to salutation to men. These are Matthew 18:26 and Revelation 3:9.
- ◆ The former scripture depicts the king as a type or picture of God (verse 29 uses a different word when used between fellow servants 'besought' 'entreat' NWT). Revelation 3:9 refers to the enemies of the church being forced to acknowledge Jesus' love for the church. Compare this with Isaiah 60:14,15.

Sadly, the Watchtower Society cannot make up its mind whether or not Jesus should be worshipped. For example, the Watchtower March 1880 page 83 says -

"to worship Christ in any form cannot be wrong."

Even as late as the Watchtower 15 October 1945, page 313, Jehovah's Witnesses were told you must worship and bow down to Jehovah's chief one, namely Jesus Christ.

However, by 1964 this was the instruction -

"...it is unscriptural for worshipers of the living and true God to render worship to the Son of God, Jesus Christ." Watchtower

1/1 V64 page 671

The idea that men only did obeisance to Jesus as to a human being, does not explain why we are to bow the knee before one we cannot literally see before us. It does not explain why Jesus is worshipped by every creature - Revelation 5:13, instead of being with them as a worshipper.

Jehovah's Witnesses are forbidden to worship Jesus and to pray to him. They will say they pray through Jesus. But please consider, what does that mean? Do we believe Jesus can hear these prayers and intercede for us? Hebrews 7:25.

Why do JW's believe it is wrong to pray through Mary or the saints?

If all the saints in every place call upon the Lord Jesus (1 Corinthians 1:2), how, if he is not God, can he hear us?

Clearly then the scriptures do teach the Divinity, yes, the Deity of the Lord Jesus.

Reprieve offered to Jehovah's Witness

A Melbourne man who defied his wife's and his church's beliefs to save her life would only be taken back by the Jehovah's Witnesses if he recanted his decision, a church minister said today.

The man won the right for doctors to give his desperately ill wife a blood transfusion on Tuesday, despite her signing a legally binding consent form that said she was not to receive any blood products.

The woman, 20, was in a coma after bleeding profusely when she developed complications after giving birth to her first child on Friday.

Jehovah's Witness minister, Mr Peter Linke, said the man would be spoken to and welcomed back into the faith only if he agreed to abide by the group's religious beliefs.

Members of the group who transgress its codes of behaviour are expelled, or "disfellowshipped", and all other members of the congregation who wish to remain in good standing with the church are urged to totally reject that person to the extent of regarding them as dead. This includes close family members.

Jehovah's Witnesses view blood as sacred and, based on a text in The Bible, believe God has forbidden humans from ingesting it in any form.

Mom torches kids Girl dies; woman, son critical

A MOTHER doused her children and herself with gasoline and set herself on fire.

The woman's daughter burned to death in a tool shed, as her fourteen-year-old brother John Kelly Blake Fausto was

feverishly dousing the flames on his younger brother and screaming for his little sister to get out of a burning shed.

Then, without a word their mother walked up, poured gasoline over herself and set herself ablaze

The first fire fighter on the scene at the home in Pheonix Arizona, had to divide his attention, and his only fire hose, between the two brothers and their mother who had turned herself into a human torch

But, by the time they got to little Venessa Blake inside the tool shed, she had burned to death

The mother, Kelly Blake, was in critical condition at Maricopa Medical Centre

Ramon Fausto, 12, was listed in critical condition and his brother, John, was in good condition at the same hospital

Jose Rojas, 13, who lives across the street from the house said he'd occasionally ride bicycles with John and Ramon but only saw them around their house.

"Never at school," he said. "Their mom wouldn't let them"

Jose said their mother forbade school for religious reasons He said he also had talked to John about why the family couldn't dress up for Halloween. He said the family were Jehovah's Witnesses.

DANGER AT YOUR DOOR

Campaign Update

OUR ongoing campaign, to put a stop to the work of visiting Jehovah's Witnesses, has received a further boost in the last three months with orders for stickers totalling more than 1,000.

Brian Meikle, who lives in Arbroath, Scotland ordered 1000 stickers and is distributing them in his area

He told Concern that he is reporting a mixed reaction. He said, "Some have taken the stickers, while others have not. For those who have taken a sticker one or two laughed, thinking it was a joke.

"Others jumped for joy (well almost) at the idea of such a thing."

As for those who refused the offer of a sticker, Brian said that some people thought it was rude to have a sticker on the door, or they preferred to tell the JW's face to face that they were not interested.

In the Autumn 1997 issue of Concern, the Rev. Richard Birch of Wiltshire gave his reasons why he thought the stickers may be counter-productive.

Here is what he had to say to our comments

Dear Friends,

Thank you for printing my three reasons against the stickers 'No Visits by JW's Please'

Thank you too for the comments by Bill Bacon. As to the first comment, I didn't realize the stickers were not for Christians.

To the second comment I still think it will strengthen the JW's faith, because this opposition makes him believe that he must have the "truth". But it's the third comment which I think you have misread me. Let me explain: for many years I have been involved in door-to-door visitation with the London City Mission, as well as each church I've been involved in, including the fellowship I am now with.

Now if we went out visiting and found 'stickers' on doors saying 'No Visits by Evangelicals Please' then our whole visitation would be hampered. Surely the better way in all this is to get Churches mobilized and out on the doors with the true Gospel of Christ.

Having said all this, I appreciate your Concern for JW's as mine is, (especially as my brother has been one for 30 years now).

Keep up the good work.

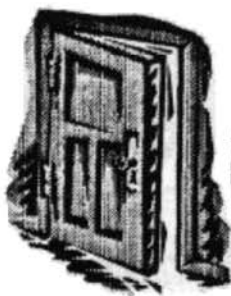

On the Doors

AFTER many years of witnessing to the Jehovah's Witnesses, here is a useful piece of information which aims to cut through all the ice and really gets to the heart of the matter and confronts them with "who Jesus really is".

You can use this either at the start when you first meet them or after you have been on the Watchtower theological roundabout.

The Witnesses want to do two things:

1. Help you,
- and
2. Answer your questions.

So then, here goes - "KNOCK, KNOCK"

After preliminary introductions (C=Christian, J=Jehovah's Witness)

C. Can you help me? (This is the key to the JW computer answering system) I have an important question I would like you to answer. (Now you have their full attention.)

C. Is Jehovah the only true God?

J. Yes he is.

C. (This is the important question) Is Jesus a true God or a false God. (Get them to answer only true or false, you do not want any other answer).

They will try to give you some other answers. Here are some of them.

J. He is a mighty God but not almighty God

J. He is a divine person

J. He has divine qualities

J. He is known as Michael the archangel

J. There are gods many and lords many

Whatever the answer they try to give, other than true or false, do not accept. Insist they answer. Here is why.

If they answer true then they have and believe in TWO TRUE GODS. If they answer false then they have a FALSE GOD who was created and is seated at the right hand of Jehovah in Heaven.

Either Jesus is a true God or he is not. You cannot have it both ways.

In doing this you are not getting bogged down in the twisting of scripture as they do. You do not have to defend the trinity doctrine. You do not have to argue with them. Most importantly you are confronting them with who they really believe Jesus is.

You will have put the spanner in the Watch Tower computer programmed answering system. They will not have been able to help you or answer your question.

As they try to skirt around the subject by attacking the trinity doctrine, agree to discuss it with them starting with Jehovah is God. Then deal with Jesus. Is he a true God or not? You will not get past this point to even discuss the Holy Spirit.

But all the time you can be praying that the Holy Spirit will open their eyes. As they go away frustrated, pray that this will play on their minds until they come to the true knowledge of Jesus and that he will become their personal saviour.
