DANGER AT YOUR DOOR

Sticker campaign launched to thwart Watch Tower door-to-door work.

UNWANTED visits by Jehovah's Witnesses could become a thing of the past if a new campaign, launched this July, proves popular with the public.

First & Last Ministries is pleased to announce the launch of the "Danger at Your Door" campaign in Britain.

This campaign will allow Christians to distribute warning tracts and door stickers to their neighbourhood and families.

But those with a desire to reach the JW's with the Gospel will leave their own front door clear giving the JW's no choice but to knock.

During a pilot-run of the campaign, carried out in north London, the public reaction was favourable with whole streets displaying stickers on their front doors.

One person, a warden of a sheltered housing block for the elderly, ordered 70 stickers.

She described the campaign as excellent.

"Why has nobody else thought of this? It's a brilliant way of stopping the Jehovah's Witnesses from calling on the vulnerable and elderly."

"If only somebody could have thought of it sooner."

Now we hope that the campaign can be spread to the whole of the country so that everyone is aware of the danger.

BBC pulls plug on Witness documentary

A DAMNING TV documentary against the Jehovah's Witnesses will not be screened nationwide, it was decided in June.

Earlier this year the BBC announced that the programme, Witnesses for the Prosecution, would be shown as part of the BBC2 TV series Home Ground.

But, in June, producers changed their mind and decided that the programme would not go ahead.

Philip Mawson, who took part in the programme, which was originally shown by BBC south-west, said he was disappointed at the decision not to screen it.

He told *Concern*: "It's a great shame that the only polemic programme that the BBC has ever done on the JW's was not chosen for the series."

"The programme made a big impact in the south-west and I'm sure it would've had an even bigger impact on a national scale."

Mr Nigel Kay, whose decision it was to cancel the programme described it as "very powerful" but explained, that out of 250 documentaries submitted for screening, this one was not chosen for the 13-part series.

DO NOT KNOCK

Campaign

EVER since First & Last Ministries was formed, over 10 years ago, it has strived to present the real Jesus Christ to those people deceived by the Watchtower Society.

And, in recent years, we have been greatly encouraged by the fact that the number of Jehovah's Witnesses has been falling.

Now, following the lead of other outreach groups, including MacGregor Ministries and Witness Inc., we have come to the conclusion that we need to expand our outreach to include warning the general public of the Watchtower evil!

How much simpler it is to prevent people from becoming Jehovah's Witnesses in the first place, than to have to pull them out by the roots many years down the road, with their lives and families in ruins

Picture this Jehovah's Witnesses are in their assigned territory, getting ready to cover your neighbourhood with their message

As they proceed to each door they are stopped dead in their tracks. What has stopped them? A dog set on them? No The threat of a soaking from a hosepipe? No Instead a little sticker has been affixed to the homeowner's door saying:



What is the JW to do? Knock anyway and annoy the householder as usual? No! The JW will obey the instructions in his own publication, Our Kingdom Ministry, 12/82, p.3.

“Occasionally we meet householders in our territory who are very opposed to our work and message. Some have even threatened us. If some adamantly request that none of Jehovah’s Witnesses call at their homes again, such requests should be respected.... Thereafter, each publisher who is asked to work this territory should be especially careful to avoid irritating the householder and not call at his home.”

If the JW should bother the householder contrary to his instructions, the householder, who has the sticker, will also have a tract called “Danger At Your Door” to present to the JW as his/her reason for the sticker

Now for the best part. Christians who are prepared for Jehovah’s Witnesses will not put such a sticker on their doors! If the Christian has approached his/her neighbours with the offer of stickers and tracts, there won’t be many houses left for the JWs to go to.

Early reports indicate that neighbours are delighted to use the stickers and thank the Christian profusely

Many Christians will find it a door-opener to present the gospel and invite people to church.

Secondly, Jehovah’s Witnesses will be curious about such a campaign and will read the warning tracts in spite of instructions to the contrary.

We expect they will gossip so much that it won’t take long to spread the news in and around the congregations

In Conclusion

- ◆ Pastors - Order enough for your church and pass them out
- ◆ Youth Groups - distribute them in a wide radius around your church
- ◆ Christians - distribute them in your neighbourhood, mail them to relatives and friends.

- ◆ Do maildrops Advertise in shop windows and newspapers - tell your local newspaper.
- ◆ If you like walking for exercise choose a different area each time and drop off tracts and stickers at each house.

We are extremely excited about this sticker and warning tract campaign


Our goal is to shut the JWs down bigtime. Neighbourhood by neighbourhood, town by town and city by city.

Fellow Christians please order as many tracts and stickers as you can and join us in exposing the danger of Jehovah’s Witnesses

Please pray for us as we begin this vital outreach work all over the country

Is The Holy Spirit A Person?

THE Watch Tower Society will go to almost any length to disprove the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ.

So it's not surprising that the third person of the Trinity, the Holy Spirit, should also come under attack from the society, likening it to nothing more than just a radar beam or electricity.

In this issue of *Concern* Robert Skynner concludes his two-part article which asks "Is the Holy Spirit a Person?"

THE Holy Spirit also prays (Rom 8 26), but how can an impersonal "it" such as a force or electricity do this? Is it not correct that only a personal being, a "he" or "she" can pray, an impersonal force an "it" can neither "pray" nor "intercede" on behalf of a personal being, (us) before another personal being (God)

The Holy Spirit can be lied to (Acts 5 3) Insulted (Heb 10 29) and blasphemed (Mark 3 29), yet how can one blaspheme electricity, energy, or insult an impersonal force? One can only blaspheme a personal being a "he" not an impersonal "it", such as electricity or "the force" of the three Star Wars films

Does Ananias lie to the Holy Spirit (Acts 5:2) or to God (Acts 5 3)? If one assumes that the word of God is truth, (rather than the teachings of a man made organisation) then the Holy Spirit spoken of in verse three, is the God of verse four

Is the prophecy spoken through Isaiah (Isa 6 9), the voice of Yahweh (Isa. 6 8, or the voice of the Holy Spirit (Acts 28 25b)? If we accept the Word of God as truth, should we not accept both statements as correct and deduce that the Holy Spirit must therefore be Yahweh?

The Holy Spirit is Omnipotent (Luke 1 35), Omnipresent (Ps 139 7-13), Omniscient (1 Cor 2 10-11), Eternal (Heb 9 14) and also Creates (Gen 1.2, Job 33 4, Ps 104 12-13, Isa 40 1-13)

All serious Bible students will agree that as only Yahweh alone possesses these five attributes, nobody, and nothing

other than Yahweh, can create (Isa. 44.24), and be eternally extant (Ps 90:2).

The Holy Spirit is sent by the Father (John 14:26). One cannot "send" an impersonal force. A "personal being", however, can be sent from one place to another place, to accomplish some specific task (as Jesus also was in Jn. 6:38)

The Masculine pronoun "he" is used nine times, (rather than the impersonal "it") to describe the Holy Spirit (Jn. 16: 13-14). The Greek word for Spirit is indeed a neuter word, however, the masculine pronoun which modifies it (nine times) clearly is used to inform us that the Holy Spirit is a personal being, and is a "he" not an "it".

John 16: 14 reads of the Holy Spirit; "He will glorify me" How can an impersonal thing, such as electricity, glorify a personal being such as Jesus?

Acts 2:33 contains the phrase "poured out". This does not prove that the Holy Spirit is not a personal being or an "it", for Jesus (Ps 22.14) and Paul (Phil. 2:17, 2 Tim 4:6) are both personal beings yet are recorded as being poured out also!

This phrase seems to imply "being given on behalf of another" with reference to some work or blessing of a spiritual nature, rather than proving "an impersonal nature".

A consideration of the Trinity is not possible in such a brief examination of the Holy Spirit such as this. Scripture however does record the Father, Son and Holy Spirit together in both the Old (Isa. 48:16-

17) and New Testaments (Mt. 3 16-17, 28:19, 2 Cor 13:14). Trinitarian theology can be simply and briefly summed up in the statement:

"There is one God who exists eternally, distinctly and personally as the Father, Son and Holy Spirit."

Trinitarian theology has never advocated three Gods (tritheism), nor that Jesus is God the Father (Sabellianism). By the phrase "God in three persons" we imply that the Father, Son and Spirit are personal beings ("he's" not "it's"), and are ways in which the one God eternally exists, (personally) yet with the Father, Son and Holy Spirit each being distinct from each other

6. The Greek word for intercedes at Rom. 8:26 is "entugchano" (1793 in Strong's Concordance). Elsewhere in Scripture we read that Jesus Christ also intercedes on behalf of believers (Rom 8:34, Heb 7:25). The words for "intercedes" at these two passages is "huperentugchano" (5241 in Strong's) which comes from two root words; "huper" (5228 in Strong's) and "entugchano" (1793, and therefore is the same basic word as that found at Rom. 8:26.

7. All Greek nouns are one of three genders - masculine, feminine or neuter; "bread" for instance is masculine, "head" is feminine and "child" is neuter. One should not reason that all masculine and feminine nouns have personality or even gender, which the neuter nouns by inference lack, therefore a neuter noun such as "Spirit" must be an impersonal "it". For instance, "babe/infant" as referring to John the Baptist (Lk. 1:41, 44) and Jesus (Lk 2:16) is a neuter noun, yet both John and Jesus as children were both personal and masculine persons, not impersonal "its". Secondly, both God the Father and Jesus are identified by the feminine noun "head" at 1 Cor. 11:3, yet, naturally enough, this should not be misconstrued to imply that god is a female deity! The personality of the Holy spirit is in fact greatly reinforced, by the noun "Spirit" being a neuter, for a neuter noun such as "Spirit" requires a neuter pronoun for a sentence to be grammatical in the Greek. However, Jesus deliberately uses the masculine personal pronoun "he" nine times (Jn. 16: 13-14) to speak of the Holy Spirit, thus breaking the rules of Greek grammar. Why would Jesus do this, unless to reinforce the point that the Holy Spirit is a personal being, a "He", rather than an impersonal "it".

Come Out from Among Them

I HAVE been a Christian for three years now, 12 years prior to that I was a Jehovah's Witness. My sister, who is a year older than me, became involved with the Witnesses first, and I just followed her.

We were very close, we were each other's best friend. During those years I was reasonably happy, although having the "fear of Jehovah" on your shoulders takes a lot of joy out of life. I never questioned the organisation with the elders, even though sometimes I had doubts.

One day I was reading a newspaper about the Waco situation and I wondered, "How could anyone believe such a lie, to follow a man like David Koresh, who claimed to be Christ?"

I asked myself, "What if I'm being lied to, also, what if Jehovah's Witnesses are a cult like people say, what shall I do, who can I ask?"

There, at the end of the article, was a telephone number, a "Helpline", praise God!

I didn't ring it straight away, because I was afraid. Sometime later I found the courage to ring. I spoke to Doug Harris of Reachout Trust in London.

Doug sent Janet (an ex-JW) to speak to me. She pointed out the lies and deception of the Watch Tower Society and gave me her testimony.

I must admit, after she left, I was afraid again, as I had never heard anyone talk so

much about Jesus and I was afraid of what Jehovah would think of me.

I asked my sister about Jesus and she quickly got the elders on to me. Luckily I escaped with no punishment. Later that weekend I returned everything Janet had given me to her friend in Alvaston, Derby.

I sighed a sigh of relief. Never again, I thought.

Unfortunately, or should I say fortunately - the seed of Jesus had been planted in my heart and I rang Janet's friend and told her that I wanted to know more.

On July 11th 1993 I went to my first Christian meeting, a celebration at the Assembly Rooms in Derby, where I asked Jesus to come into my life.

During my three year journey with Christ, I have made several attempts to

go back to the Witnesses. Not because I believed they were true, but because the cutting off from my sister and family has worn me down.

Their constant shunning every day has been too much to bear at times. Also the same treatment from my Witness friends.

It's hard to describe the mental torment this causes.

Janet said it was as if I was on a piece

of elastic and she never knew from one week to the next if I was in or out

However, I know that the love I have for Jesus, the Eternal Light He has placed in my heart, and knowing He is with me in the darkness, is what brings me safely home again

It's been hard, it's been painful, but it's also brought me closer to God

One night, through tears, I asked the Lord, "Why didn't you bring my sister out first, I would have followed her"?

Jesus said, "Because I wanted you to follow me".

God has given me new friends, He's given me so much joy and happiness He has given me hope He has given me my own personality He has given me a husband who is a tower of strength, whose love has overwhelmed me at times

God gave His own son, Jesus Christ, to die for me, and all He asks of me is that I believe and be baptised.

THE FINAL INSULT

What an insult it is when groups like the Watchtower Society demote Jesus from His status as eternal creator (Jn 1 3) to a being belonging to time "the first creature"

If this were not bad enough the Watchtower Society also teaches that Jesus had to be Born Again (regenerated) and that He became God's spiritual son at His baptism by John the Baptist See (Greatest Man book - story 12) and (Reasoning Book p 76)

But a further insult comes in the Watchtower of April 15, 1995 on pages 19-20 where it states in paragraph 21

"Logically the preeminent name written in Jehovah's book of life is that of the Chief Agent of life, God's own Son Jesus Christ What a privilege it is to have our individual names added to Jesus' name in that scroll!"

So, in Watchtower Christology, Jesus Christ is the first creature, the first to be Born Again, and now the first to get His name written in Jehovah's Book of Life

This is absolute anathema from the Biblical view held by the historic Christian church, which teaches that Jesus Christ is fully God and created all things (Heb 3 4),

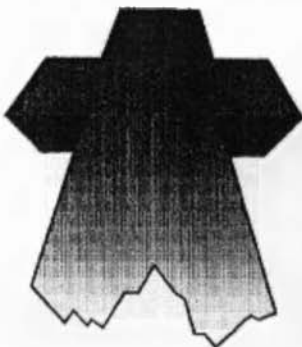
that He did not need to be regenerated (born again), because He was never degenerated by sin (Heb 4 15, 7 26) and finally Jesus Christ does not have to have His name written in "Jehovah's Book of Life" because the Book of Life is the Lamb's very own book (Rev 13 8) It is He who has written the names of God's elect in it according to His eternal plan and that He will not blot out those names of God's redeemed elect (cf Rev.3 5)

William Hendriksen, in his book "More Than Conquerors", states aptly on p.147

"But even in these most dreadful days that shall precede Christ's second coming there will be believers on earth, those whose names have been written from eternity in the

Lamb's Book of Life Because of the fact that God has elected them from eternity to salvation in sanctification of the Spirit and belief in the truth (2 Thess 2 13) these individuals cannot perish"
